



2020 Pines Village Craft Fair

You must agree to the below Terms & Regulations while completing your application.

Space Assignments –

Space is designated as 10X10 “Booth.” Booth will be assigned in advance by the Pines Resort. This is to best accommodate all vendors and maximize the venue space. Please set up in the designated booth and do not switch or move booths without the approval. If you have any concerns, please contact our Event Manager, Kim Castiglione. Exhibitor agrees to hold harmless the Pines Resort from any liability, which may result from booth assignment or any cause.

Payments and Cancellations-

In applying for space, the Exhibitor/Vendor will pay \$150 per booth as a space deposit. This fee is subject to discount in case of multi-event participation, as advertised. In the event of cancellation by the Exhibitor at any time, the Pines shall have the right to lease the space to anyone else without obligation to return the monies already paid and the right to retain such amount as liquidated damages. Any dues for the rental booth space is to be paid at the time of application. For the convenience of our vendors, The Pines Resort is also allowing to remit the payment in three equal payments (at the time of application, by May, by September). No exhibitor can set up without full payment of booth(s) leased. We accept credit/debit card payments online.

Booths and Equipment –

Each vendor is responsible for the safe set-up of the booth. Storing of inventory outside of the booth will not be allowed. If you do not keep your inventory within the boundaries of your booth, you will be asked to adjust your set up. All empty crates and boxes may be stored under tables within your booth. Fire rules prohibit storage of boxes, crates, or product outside the defined booth area. No exhibitor shall assign, sub-let or share the whole or any part of the booth space allotted without the express written permission of the Pines resort. If a vendor utilizes a vacant space or encroaches upon any used space, they will be billed for the additional space used. All aisle solicitation is not allowed. Booth attendants must confine their activities within the Exhibitor's booth. Distribution of printed matter shall be restricted to the Exhibitor's booth and must be distributed in a manner that will not interfere with other Exhibitors.

Objectionable Materials and Activities –

The Pines resort reserves the right to refuse any exhibit, or any exhibitor, or any employees, which or who in the opinion of Pines resort is not keeping with the character of the show, and may at any time without notice, cancel the agreement and remove the Lessee, his agents and property from the building. In the event of such cancellation, the Exhibitor hereby waives any claim for damages or for the recovery of any rental monies.

Installation and dismantling of Exhibits –

Vendor must have booth set and ready for guest no later than 9:45 AM on beginning date of craft fair. Vendor CANNOT breakdown Booth until 2pm on last day of craft fair. Please double check the dates and days of the craft fair – there are 2-; 3- and 4-day events. If the Vendor is found to be breaking down booth before said time they will be fined \$25.

Liabilities The Exhibitor is liable for any damage to hotel property or exhibits

The Exhibitor agrees to make no claims for any reason whatsoever, including negligence and/or omissions Resort, and their representatives or agents for: loss, theft, damage, or destruction of goods; injury to himself by virtue of failure to provide space or removal of exhibit, any action of any nature of the above organization or its agents, failure to hold exhibition as scheduled, or for any cause that may render exhibit area unusable. Acceptance of an Exhibit/Exhibitor by The Pines Resort in no way endorses the Exhibit/Exhibitor's techniques, materials or conclusions. In view of the foregoing, it is suggested that the exhibitor obtain appropriate insurance for loss or damage to exhibit material.

Cancelled Convention or Exhibit –

Home Away Inc. and employees will not be liable if the convention and tradeshow are not held as scheduled due to fire, act of God, weather, terrorism, public enemy, labor strike, epidemic, or any law or regulation of Public Authority, which makes it impossible or impractical to hold the Exhibition. If the exhibits are called off on or before date of event then payments for booth space will be returned, except for any actual expense incurred in the connection with the exhibits. If cancelled after April 1, 2020 no refunds will be made, but rather a credit will be issued to vendor which can be applied to future scheduled Pines Village Craft Fair.

We ask that the vendors park in the upper parking lot (above the Post Office) or in the church parking lot. No alcohol or drugs on premises and proper attire at all times.
